Covid-19 Testing Update

Further to our Parentmails of 5^{th} and 6^{th} January, the Government guidelines with regard to testing for Covid-19 have changed. Details of the current requirements are as follows:

From 11 January in England, people who receive a positive lateral flow (LFD) test result for coronavirus (COVID-19) will be required to self-isolate immediately and won't be required to take a confirmatory PCR test. This is a temporary measure while COVID-19 rates remain high across the UK. Whilst levels of COVID-19 are high, the vast majority of people with positive LFD results can be confident that they have COVID-19.

Lateral flow tests are taken by people who do not have COVID-19 symptoms. Anyone who develops 1 of the 3 main COVID-19 symptoms should stay at home and self-isolate and take a PCR test. They must self-isolate if they get a positive test result, even if they have had a recent negative lateral flow test - these rules have not changed.

Under this new approach, anyone who receives a positive LFD test result should report their test result at https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result and must self-isolate immediately but will not need to take a follow-up PCR test. After reporting a positive LFD test result, they will be contacted by NHS Test and Trace so that their contacts can be traced and must continue to self-isolate.

As set out in the Parentmail of 6th January, anyone who has tested positive for Covid-19 may now take lateral flow tests on day 6 and day 7 of their self-isolation period. Please note that the day on which symptoms began (or the test was taken if no symptoms) is day 0. Those who receive two negative test results are no longer required to complete 10 full days of self-isolation. The first test must be taken no earlier than day 6 of the self-isolation period and tests must be taken 24 hours apart. If both these test results are negative, and your child does not have a high temperature, they may end their self-isolation after the second negative test result and return to school.

Your child should not return to school if either of the tests is positive, or if they have a high temperature. In this event they should continue to self-isolate.

Your child may finish self-isolation once they have two negative lateral flow test results on two consecutive days, from day 6 onwards of their self-isolation (and do not have a high temperature), or after completing 10 days of self-isolation.

1	Begin counting self-isolation days

In order to help prevent the spread of Covid-19 in school, we will from now inform parents/carers if there is a positive PCR or LFD test result within their child's class. In this instance, we ask that you endeavour to test your child daily with a LFD test for the following seven days, as this will help minimise the possibility of the virus spreading. Your child should continue to attend school as normal unless they have a positive LFD test result or develop symptoms. Information on accessing LFD tests can be found here:
